THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY #6,

- P1. *Seeking* closer ties with supranational organisations,
- P2. *Acknowledging* the involvement of misinformation in the erosion of trust within humanitarian organisations, hindering the distribution of aid to Ukraine,
- P3. *Noting* the importance of clear communication to rebuild trust between supranational institutions and the public,
- O1. Emphasises the effects of the veto powers used by members of the UNSC delaying peace talks, therefore conducting a UN backed inquiry into the veto powers,  
i) If P5 countries used a veto, they are required to make a public explanation, moderated by a non-state affiliated member of the UN,
- O2. Encourages supranational organisations to make information on their activities readily available to the public and implementing clear procedures in order to maintain a healthy communication and rebuild trust,
- O3. Requests active involvement from any countries being oppressed by war in decision making processes within international organisations to ensure our perspectives are heard and acknowledged,  
i) Countries oppressed by war will be verified from a general assembly vote enhancing credibility
- O4. Request the security council to debate additional representations of five more temporary members in order to award additional geographically equitable representations in security council,
