P1. Observing the catastrophic effects of the January 2025 Southern California wildfires, including the deaths of 30 people,

P2. Realising the importance of improving strategies of wildfire response in minimising casualties caused by wildfires,

P3. Having adopted the Executive Order titled Empowering Commonsense Wildfire Prevention and Response calling for modernisation and improved coordination in response to wildfires,

P4. Noting that the threat of wildfires is an international concern shared by many of the UN member states,

O1. Calls upon international awareness of the need to optimise wildfire response now in preparation for wildfires in the future

O2. Recommends UN member states to consider modernising approaches, including utilizing artificial intelligence

O3. Encourages the creation of policies by UN member states to ensure decisive preparative action is taken
