- P1. *Desiring* an increased drive towards disarmament for an uptake in peaceful resolutions,
  - P2. *Convinced* that sect based violence will only escalate without proper regulations on arms trades,
  - P3. *Taking into consideration* the perceived inevitability of the involvement of cyber technologies in future conflicts,
  - P4. *Noting with objection* the devastating environmental impact of many proposed military endeavours,

- O1. Requests the gradually end to all space and biological weapon production, including research,
  - O2. Calls for the temporary demilitarisation of the India-Pakistan border to facilitate peaceful negotiations and avoid the escalation of conflict under the shadow of emerging warfare technologies,
  - O3. Recommends heightened sanctions for the abuse of cyber warfare,
  - O4. Emphasises the necessity of environmental consciousness in the field of modern warfare technologies regardless of stance around their use,
  - O5. Urges the adoption of a stance of increased hypervigilance surrounding unsanctioned arms deals and the tacit support in foreign countries.
