- P1. *Concerned* that major disease outbreaks over the last 25 years, including SARS, H1N1, and Ebola, have exposed severe weaknesses in healthcare systems and proved that countries are not fully prepared to handle public health crises,
  - P2. *Emphasising* that the unregulated spread of extremist ideas inside online networks is a direct threat to national security and public order,
  - P3. *Realising* that the evolution of digital communication from 1990s internet bulletin boards to modern networks allowed terrorist groups like ISIL to spread graphic propaganda across state lines and directly exploit youth,

- O1. Urges member states to strengthen their national health systems by supporting private pharmaceutical research, utilizing artificial intelligence for faster medical imaging, and adopting new wearable healthcare technologies,
  - O2. Calls upon member states to enforce strict age limits and state-backed digital protections to shield young people from harmful online material.
  - O3. Calls for strict state laws that force social media networks to rapidly delete terrorist content and extremist accounts or face immediate domestic penalties,
