THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

1. *Acknowledging* the staggering amount of space debris which oppose risk onto active satellites, the International Space Station and future projects,
 2. *Realising* the importance of maintaining the involvement of other countries, not just former colonial powers.
-
1. Calls upon all UN states to comply with the Inter-Agency Space Debris Coordination Committee (IADC), and ensure sustainable development of satellites and other space infrastructure,
 2. Urges states to work with IADC to promote waste reduction within the space industry,
 3. Endorses the collaboration between BSA and its previous colonial power, England, to allow BSA to have equitable access to space technology and capacity-building support for other neighbouring Arabian developing countries,
 4. Emphasising, UN is urged to adopt a binding treaty of space debris reduction by incorporating strict accountability of other UN nations' space vandalism with their ecocide.
