

Title: Upholding the territorial integrity of Eastern European nations

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

1. *Recalling* the principle of Article 2(4) of the UN charter in terms of the sovereignty for Eastern European nations,
2. *Recognising* the absolute necessity to protect Eastern European nations from all military and socio-economic pressures from imperial states for the future,
3. *Taking into consideration* how modern Eastern European nations are having their right to self-determination breached,
4. *Acknowledging* the impact and influence of power dynamics between Eastern European nations towards each other,
5. *Concerned* with the funding of de facto separatist movements used as an attempt to erase the self-governance of a nation,

1. Requests that all UN member states follow Article 2(4) of the UN charter to prevent further breaches in sovereignty.
2. Urges UN member states to discuss territorial disputes through diplomacy with organisations, such as the OSCE, rather than military action to promote long term stability and independence of the European region.
3. Recommends the Security Council impose economic sanctions and diplomatic restrictions on nations who infringe on the autonomy of other nations through socio-economic and military pressures.
4. Recommends the Security Council enforce severe military and arms embargoes on nations who repeatedly go against Article 2(4) of the UN charter by instigating armed conflicts.
5. Recommends the Security Council to enforce the withdrawal of illegal foreign troops and funding of proxy-nations and de facto separatist movements across Eastern European nations to prevent a nation's authority being undermined by foreign powers.
